HAMLETS

The monthly meeting of the Parish Council was held on Wednesday 18th October. Attended by: Cllrs. J Hobbs (Chair), G Worden, K Jones, S Tilbey, C Myers and the Clerk – S Rosser. Apologies for absence were received and accepted from: Cllrs. K Boundy, J Payne, J Phipps & N Steer. Cllr. Savage did not attend.

Cornwall Councillor Shorne Tilbey gave a report of recent meetings attended in past weeks. These mainly centred around future provision for both health & social care and children's services. Finalised information will be available on this next month. An officer from Bude Police Station – P.C. Lee Skinner would like to come to Morwenstow to host a 'beat surgery' in the future. The Community Chest Fund is now open and accepting applications. Please visit the parish website for more information on how to apply; or see further details in the Hamlets.

The usual monthly matters of parish maintenance were covered. The section of highway near Shop (mentioned in the Hamlets in September) will be having work carried out by Cornwall Council Highways very soon.

The Health & Wellbeing Project public meeting took place as planned on Monday 9th October. The plans were agreed to go forward, as previously suggested. The planning application has been resubmitted. We await further news. The steering group will start the process again of competitively pricing the items. One planning application was considered: PA23/08119 | Application for Non-Material Amendment to PA21/03597 for a Proposed replacement dwelling and associated landscaping and external renovation works to curtilage structure (Former Laundry), namely 1) Extended roof terrace and associated privacy screen to east wing omitted; 2) Eastern wing reduced in length by approximately 600mm in conjunction with reviewed internal floor layout including revised curvature of north-eastern corner to match south-western corner of western wing; 3. Northern single storey carport wing adjusted and layout reconfigured (including omission of extent of habitable accommodation); 4. Minor adjustments to fenestration of north elevation of eastern wing in conjunction with 1. / 2. / 3. above. | White Oak Farm Morwenstow Bude Cornwall EX23 9JL

NATURE NOTES

We are led to believe that the British Isles enjoy a temperate climate, with a variation of weather conditions throughout the year keeping the countryside green & healthy for the benefit of plant & animal life.

But with the extremes of storms & rainfall experienced in some areas over recent weeks the people of those areas must be thinking that our climate is changing to a tropical one.

Since the turn of the century our winters have been much milder which means that our youngsters will not have memories of snowdrifts and frozen water pipes. To have a vivid memory of such events you had to be there in person and experience it 100% with all your senses as opposed to what is available as an image on a screen.

Back in the early summer the hawthorn blossom created the effect of huge snowballs & now the berries are the colour of red-hot embers and will be appreciated by the flocks of redwing & fieldfare when they arrive from Northern Europe.

Surprisingly some of the garden shrubs & flowers are giving an extended burst of colour for us to enjoy. Some of ours have not been planted, but have grown from seed that just happened to be in the soil, so when you are weeding do not hoe out everything you haven't planted or can't identify as a weed.
