HAMLETS

The monthly meeting of the Parish Council was held on Wednesday 17th April 2024. Attended by: Cllrs. Phipps (Chair), K Boundy, G Worden, N Steer, C Myers, J Payne, S Tilbey & the Clerk. Apologies for absence were received and accepted from: Cllrs. J Hobbs, K Jones & R Savage. No members of the public attended.

County Councillor Tilbey gave a report of his recently attended meetings. This included Full Council, a meeting with the local community beat officer – Nina Sargent (also attended by Cllr. Myers). The Children & Families Overview & Scrutiny Committee have their annual youth council event on 26th April between 4 & 6pm in Truro.

The usual matters maintenance discussed included highways repairs and signage. The defibrillator at the Community Centre is now formally being gifted to the Morwenstow United Charities from South West Ambulance Service Trust. The maintenance of this will be supported by both the MUC and the PC. Cllr. Jones continues to promote the 'Invasive Species Survey' - please see the March issue for details, you can also find these on the Parish website.

The Expression of Interest response was received between meetings from Cornwall Council. Morwenstow Parish Council have been invited to submit a full application for funding of the Health & Well Being Project. The steering group will drive this forward.

Two planning applications were considered: PA24/02072 | Phased residential development for 4 dwellings | Land West Of Woodridge Wooley Morwenstow Bude Cornwall EX23 9PW. MPC Comments: Morwenstow Parish Council are pleased to see that more detail of surface water drainage; and how it will be addressed, has been included within this application. However, we still feel unable to support this application. The bulk & massing of the proposal creates urbanisation of the countryside. Our previous comments of PA23/05306 are still relevant.

PA24/01720 | Outline Application for one new dwelling, with all matters reserved except for access. | Land Between Foxhaven and Meadow View Eastcott Bude Cornwall – Cllr. Payne left the room whilst this application was discussed. MPC Comments: Morwenstow Parish Council have the same comments as before for application PA23/05690 of which was refused. Nothing material has changed since appeal decision: APP/D0840/W/16/3163814 was dismissed. We are therefore unable to support this application.
