Mission:

To improve general health and wellbeing within the Parish of Morwenstow by enhancing the outdoor facilities at Morwenstow Community Centre.

This comprises of three elements – adult exercise facilities, children's (and adults) skate/bike facilities and an all weather sporting facility to aid the existing successful football club, including use for all members of the community.

This vision also incorporates the addition of a power supply to provide the facility of electric vehicle charging.

Multi Use Games Area:

Size: 42m x 33m—Accommodation for general play/ training and league matches for Under 7's & Under 8's football teams.


Surface: 3G using 50mm pile height synthetic turf

To cater for Bikes, BMX's, Scooters, Skateboards & Roller Skating.


Size: Approximately 150 metres long & 2 metres wide

Surface: Asphalt


Cost: Ballpark—£50,000.00

Area: Space below the current training pitch.


