Proposal: Non-material amendment (1) to vary the fencing material from the approved metal chain link mesh security fencing to deer stock fencing consisting of wooden posts and wire in respect of decision notice PA10/08695 - installation of a solar energy facility on land near Eastcott Cross, near Bude. The facility would include up to 75,000 photovoltaic panels to produce 5 megawatts of renewable electricity for export to the regional electricity network. Up to 10 small buildings would also be required to house inverters (which convert the direct current produced by the panels into alternating current for export to the grid). Another building would be required to house additional electrical equipment. Permeable access tracks will be installed on the site for the use by construction vehicles
