2.	Apologies: All present
3.	Election of Officers took place. Positions remained the same with the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Chair – Cllr Jonathan Hobbs, Proposed by Cllr R Savage, seconded by Cllr J Phipps – all in favour.• Vice – Chair – Cllr Julie Phipps, Proposed by Cllr S Tilbey, seconded by Cllr N Steer – all in favour.
